### Our position

- The European Movement in Scotland (EMiS) believes that **Scotland and the UK should return to EU membership.**
- That's what we campaign to achieve, while supporting all initiatives that take us closer to the EU and closer to our eventual return to EU membership.
- We believe that we are more secure and more prosperous when we work in close harmony and cooperation with our friends and neighbours in Europe.
- We believe that the closer and sooner we return to key EU economic programmes – the Single Market and the Customs Union – the better for the Scottish economy, Scottish jobs, Scottish trade, Scottish tourism, Scottish higher education and Scotland's performers, musicians and artists.
- We believe that the better we know our friends and neighbours in Europe the greater the chances of avoiding war on our continent.
- We are a membership organisation open to all who believe what we believe.
- EMiS is not affiliated to any political party.



### Our strategy

- Ten years ago, **Scotland voted by 62% for the UK to remain in the EU.**
- The strength of our cause comes from the democratic will of the Scottish people.
- Our strategy is to present the case for the EU to the Scottish public through our own digital platforms, through meetings, debates, talks and street stalls, in the media and directly with politicians in Edinburgh, London and Brussels.

### Our actions during the Scottish general election campaign

- EMiS will focus on the survey findings of January 2026 that found that **73% of voters in Scotland want to reverse Brexit.**
- We will ask voters to "Vote for what Scotland wants" because nearly three quarters of all Voters in Scotland want to see us back in the EU.
- We will say to voters that when they vote in the general election that they vote for parties that will take us back to the EU.
- Through social media and the press, we will urge voters in Scotland to ask candidates in their own areas where they stand on Scotland in Europe.
- We will say that in a world full of risks we are better off with our closest friends and neighbours in the EU.
- And, for security, peace and prosperity we are better off in the EU.
